Abortion on Demand

Steve Pearce supports legal protection for unborn children, and opposes abortion on demand.

Partial-Birth Abortion

The partial-birth abortion procedure – used from the fifth month on – involves pulling a living baby feet-first out of the womb, except for the head, puncturing the skull and suctioning out the brain. The great majority of partial-birth abortions are performed on healthy babies of healthy mothers.

Steve Pearce opposes partial-birth abortion, and voted for the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act.

Tom Udall voted **against** a bill to ban partial-birth abortions. This would have allowed partial-birth abortions to continue with no restrictions.

Taxpayer Funding of Abortion
